Maintenance of Indian Remy Hair

WWHI reminds you that virgin hair has not been processed in a acid bath unlike some of the other Indian Remy Hair, it is cuticle virgin hair and curls are steamed, permed into place to make the hair curl: it is the most natural looking curly hair.

WWHI does not recommend that you weave more than 2 layers per row. Too many layers per row will make it difficult to comb/brush the hair, which will cause the hair to tangle. For best results, **WWHI** does not recommend mixing different types of hair and different textures of hair together.

When maintaining VIRGIN INDIAN REMY HAIR YOU MUST USE LOW AKALINE SHAMPOOS. There are some products that **WWHI** recommends for maintenance of Virgin Indian Remy Hair.

- Shampoos with ultra moisturizing Crème of Nature
- Use leave in Moisture Conditioners (Do not use leave in conditioner that a high water soluble we recommend Hair Vite 100% Human Hair Treatment

Always shampoo the hair using a downward motion. Use your fingers in a horizontal motion between wefts to clean your scalp. Of course, your want to rinse the hair until all remaining product is out of hair.

Conditioning your hair is crucial to its maintenance. However, it is possible to over condition the hair. Some signs that the hair is over-conditioned are brittleness and tangling. If this does occur, your best resource is to use a deep-cleansing shampoo. **WWHI** recommends Sulfate Free Shampoo twice followed by a Moisturizing Shampoo.

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Try to avoid hair sprays that contain alcohol. Alcohols can be very drying to the hair. Finishing products leave a build up on the hair, therefore it is recommended that you use deep-cleansing shampoo once or twice a month. Build up can make the hair dry and cause tangling. After shampoo and conditioning apply Hair Vite 100% Human Hair Treatment to hair and style as usual.

Be sure to brush out the hair and remove all the tangles before you shampoo. Believe it or not, this short step is helpful in preventing knots that can be locked in by water.

ALWAYS USE COOL TO TEPID WATER TO SHAMPOO HAIR, this will keep the life of hair longer.

HAND TIED WEFTS

Never cut any part of the top of the wefts. These hand tied wefts are delicate! If they are cut WWHI cannot guarantee they will not shed! However, if you cut hand tied weft you must reinforce the end of that you cut or hair will unravel or shed. Reinforce the end that you cut with hair glue. Apply 1 ½ inches long from end of cut to the weft apply hair glue then fold then use blow dryer to secure the fold and make sure that the glue is dry. Reinforce by sewing that end and then continue to apply hand tied hair. This procedure is used every time you cut the hand tied hair to ensure that the hair does not unravel from the weft.

CURLY TEXTURE INDIAN REMY HAIR AND ALL OTHER TEXTURES

We you sleep we recommend that you wrap, braid, or ponytail the hair together to prevent tangling. This tip will save you time spent in the morning having to untangle your hair!

IF YOU PERM, BLEACH, OR COLOR THE HAIR, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK. WWHI DOES NOT GUARANTEE ANY HAIR THAT HAS BEEN CHEMICALLY ALTERED! If you decide to chemically alter your hair, we suggest you do a strand test first!

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How to shampoo and maintain Indian Remy Lace Wigs.

Lace wigs are professional products and it is extremely important you familiarize yourself with the texture of your lace wig. Only use products that work well with your lace unit's texture. Some products you use on your own natural hair may not work well with your Full lace unit.

1. Before you shampoo your Full Lace Unit, gently brush using detangling brush or leave-in conditioner such as Brandywine to soften the unit so you do not pull on the fragile knots as this may cause shedding. Brush from tip of the wig to base, never begin brushing from top or middle as this may cause damage or tangle the unit.
2. Ensure you have cleaned and removed any adhesive or tape residue around the perimeters of the lace using soft bristle brush and Oil based solvents such as C-22
3. Place your full lace wig on the Styrofoam head and use T pins to gently secure.
4. In a spray bottle, mix a capful of shampoo and fill the remaining with Luke warm or cool water. It is very important to use a shampoo that is suitable for your Lace Wig texture.

Products that work well are Silicon mix, Aveda, Paul Mitchell.

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5. Place your Full Lace Wig on the Styrofoam head under a gentle stream of cold or luke warm water and pour or spray shampoo mix evenly over the wig and use a wide tooth rounded edge brush to distribute the shampoo evenly. Remember to always comb from ends of the hair to the root, never from top or middle.

6. Rinse your unit thoroughly on the Styrofoam head using gentle stream of cold water.

7. In a spray, mix a capful of conditioner and fill the remaining with cool water. It is important to use conditioner products that are suitable with your full lace wig texture. Products we recommend are silicon mix, Redken Smooth down, Aveda, Paul Michelle

8. Place your Lace Wig on the Styrofoam head under a gentle stream of cool water. Pour or spray the conditioner mixture evenly over the unit and using a wide tooth rounded end comb to distribute the mixture all over the unit from tip to root of the unit. Remember not to comb from top or middle as this may cause damage or tangling.

For deep conditioning - you may a moisturizing conditioner and allow to sit for 5 minutes before rinsing with cool water. This product will soften, restore and revive your unit sealing all split ends.

9. Rinse your Full lace Wig thoroughly on the Styrofoam wig head in a gentle stream of cool water.

10. Towel blot your Full Lace Wig with a towel in gentle patting motions.

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Spray or apply your leave in conditioner if desired and allow to air dry.

11. To minimize shedding, We recommend the application of Knot Sealer. This is done by turning the unit inside out and spraying the knot sealer inside of the base of your unit and dry with warm hair dryer. 2-3 coats of the knot sealer is recommended.

12. Style your Full lace Wig as desired. Remember not to apply to many oil based products on the unit as this may weigh down the hair and cause tangling.

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How to maintain and care for Curly Full Lace Wig

This texture can be challenging if you are not experienced in how to care for curly hair. Be very gentle combing through your Curly Lace Wig.

Follow all the above steps. And ensure you use products that are suitable for Curly hair texture. Do not apply too many products such as moose, serums, and gels as this may cause build up on the hair and may provoke tangling and make hair harder to manage. Less is more. Hair should always have MOVEMENT!

DO NOT brush Curly Full Lace Wig as this may change pattern of natural curls. You may use your fingers to separate the curls.

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Consider braiding your Curly Texture Full Lace Wig at night before sleeping it will maintain curl pattern and reduce restyling.
